1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Defendants pay the Plaintiff's costs on a partial indemnity scale in the amount of \$290,106.69, particularized as follows:

- 4. **THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS** that post-judgment interest at the rate of 6% on the amount of the costs awarded at the costs hearing as set out in paragraph 3 shall be calculated from the date of the costs ruling, specifically June 4, 2007.
